Compassion in Peru: Over the course of 9 days, CompassionLink was able to meet with 544 individuals, and offered advice through spiritual and physical counseling.

Peru-2018

Up in the mountains of Peru, Cesar, a local farmer, had to deal with growing back pain from his hours of hard labor. In this remote village, Cesar has no easy access to medical care, and the closest doctors are too far away for him to travel. Cesar must work through the pain if he is to care for his family.

In March CompassionLink partnered with Evangel University- to send a team of premed students to help do medical assessments, give out eyeglasses, and do basic dental work. This outreach also provided an evangelistic opportunity for local AG missionaries, Chris & Debbie Bowser, as well as

the Peruvian national church. The students worked closely under volunteer medical professionals, including two Peruvian providers, to serve the villagers of Maranura.

The locals spoke Quechuan, an ancient Peruvian language few outsiders understand. Despite the language barrier, the translators on the team were able to communicate with locals like Cesar, to give him the knowledge and care he needs to properly treat his back pain. In the nine days our team was there, we saw over 544 patients. We are excited to see how the local church will be strengthened through the ministry of the Bowsers.
